## THE 3 "P'S"



### PRACTICAL:

Can you move freely in your clothes? Are your shoes safe? Have you dressed appropriately for the weather?



### PROFESSIONAL:

Are your clothes clean and wrinkle-free? Are your clothes free of graphics, brand names or sayings? Are you projecting an image of success?



### PROPER:

Rules for body exposure: no cleavage or bra exposure, no belly or behind exposure. Appropriate skirt and short length must be observed, and any large tattoos or piercings covered.
