Language

Basic beginners baby signs
(Sign as we go about daily activities)
Eye contact while talking
Mimicking sounds back and forth
Reading books together
Nursery rhymes

Auditory

Singing to baby
Talking to baby
Listening to music
Mimicking sounds back and forth
("la-la-la", "ba-ba-ba", etc.)
Clapping and tapping
